

Solid Waste Non-Ad Valorem Assessment FAQs

Who received this notice?

Residents living in unincorporated Sarasota County who are serviced by Waste Management for garbage, recycling, and yard waste collection services.

What does this notice contain?

The notice provides information about increases to the solid waste non-ad valorem assessment that will be discussed during a public hearing on Sept. 13. The hearing will be held at the downtown Administration Center, 1660 Ringling Blvd., Sarasota, beginning at 5:30 p.m.

Is this a new tax?

No, this is not a new tax. It is an increase in the existing non-ad valorem assessment.

How much are the rates increasing?

If adopted during the public hearing Sept. 13, rates will increase by 7%. This equates to \$15.28 for Class I dwelling units and by \$12.93 for Class II dwelling units.
