

TRI-PAR ESTATES PARK AND RECREATION DISTRICT POLICY AND PROCEDURE MANUAL

ITEM 5.03 GUEST USES OF TRI-PAR RECREATION FACILITIES

A. Guest use: Guests of residents may enter and use facilities if accompanied by the resident.

B. Guest Fobs: If residents desire their guests to use pool or other facilities without accompaniment by the resident, then the resident must get their guests a guest fob that will be activated for the dates of the visit.

1. Guest fobs will be activated for a maximum of 30 days.
2. A maximum of four persons may be included on each guest fob.
3. Resident must sign application accepting responsibility for any misconduct or damage to facilities.
4. There will be a \$40.00 deposit for each guest fob. The deposit will be refunded when fob is returned at end of visit.
5. A list of authorized guests that have been issued fobs will be posted in pool area each day, for verification by pool patrol or residents that person(s) in area are included on a valid fob.
6. Guests must adhere to all pool and facility rules. *Guest fobs may be revoked immediately upon misconduct or violation.*
7. See Item 5.07 for complete policy and procedure regarding fobs.

C. Guest Limitations:

1. Guests under age 45: These under-age guests are limited by deed restrictions to 30 cumulative days in any 12-month period.
2. Guests age 45 and older: Guest status is limited to 30 days. Beyond 30 days, these persons must register as Resident Visitors, and are subject to rules and policies for residents.
3. See Item 5.01 Categories of Residents, for definition of guests.
