SUNDAY

Ethics Training

- Sunshine Law – As manager I should not ask what other trustees think about an issue. I don’t believe I have done this but listen to your concerns and thoughts individually.
- Public Records – Chapter 119 - They are open and available and do not have to be requested in writing. They can be requested orally. There are set fees for copies and time charges. There is a retention manual for required time that we must retain the records. All documents can be scanned with all information but must be redacted for personnel information when public records are requested. Purge records frequently. Example was someone asking for all records that had the word “District” in it.
- Ethics – Chapter 112 – before July 1st must file who your coordinator of financial disclosure.

MONDAY

- Protecting your District from fraud. HB 967 Electronic Payments Made to Local Governments “The bill requires each unit of local government, including all municipalities, special districts, counties, and county constitutional officers, to accept payment by use of credit cards, charge cards, bank debit cards, and electronic fund transfers for financial obligations owed to the local government, except when another form of payment is required by law. The bill also requires local governments to have an online method to accept payments. If approved by the Governor, or allowed to become law without the Governor's signature, these provisions take effect on January 1, 2027.”
- AI and the importance in Special Districts. Software is crucial. Some terminology: Silos “old way of doing things” need for change. If you want to go deeper

- Should have a backup Wi-Fi in case main one goes down.
- **Keeper**, RoboForm or similar software for keeping passwords or NEVER have passwords saved on paper or in Google Passwords

Resident on 1877 Cypress Point -expressed concern for voting too quickly and requested the board delay until snowbirds return. Questioned how to get a monthly report of the Flea Market funds and how they are dispersed. Questioned if funds were moved to a separate sub account. Asked how requests for funds be handled.

Resident on Cherry Hill asked if trustees can drive the TriPar vehicle.

Remote resident stated she is still not in support of the current draft policy. Questioned why the Financial Committee has to change to Financial Advisory.

8. NEW BUSINESS

- Vote on Flea Market Operation to accept attorneys' draft for Flea Market Operations as written with noted changes re: Park employee rather than Park Maintenance Manager. **Passed 5 yes 2 no.**
- Bylaws amendments to review further the Statutes about remote trustees and their ability to vote remotely.
